Worship Notes

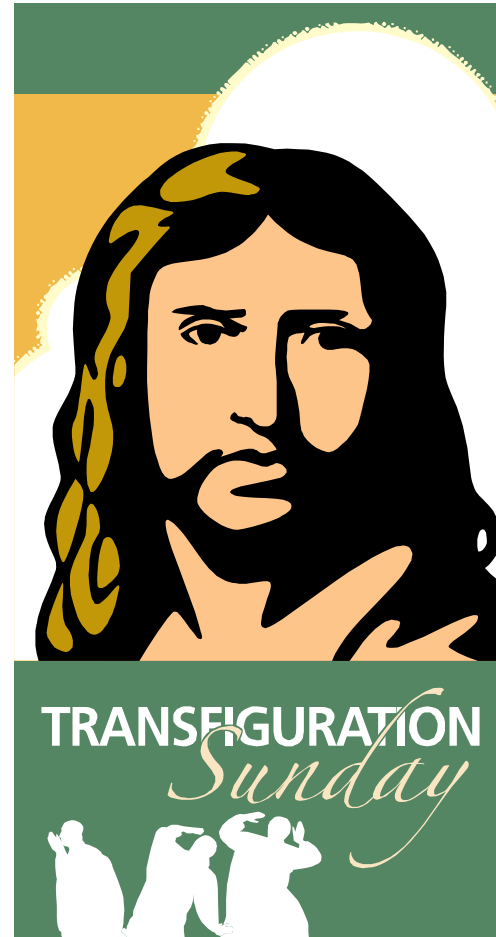
